# PAT MEDICAL REFERRAL GUIDELINES for NON-CARDIAC CONDITIONS SWA 2021

## Pre-operative conditions that require medical optimization

## ACUTE MEDICAL CONDITIONS

- DBP over 110
- Unexplained SOB
- Room air SaO<sub>2</sub> below 94 with no history of chronic lung disease
- Poorly controlled asthma
- Unexplained findings on lung auscultation

## ABNORMAL LAB VALUES

- Random BS over 350
- K<sup>+</sup> under 3.0
- K<sup>+</sup> over 5.4 without ESRD
- HCT under 24 without ESRD
- Abnormal INR/PTT without anticoagulants
- Platelet count < 90

## HIGH RISK FOR POST-OP PULMONARY COMPLICATIONS

- Major surgery and severe chronic lung disease
- Major surgery and frailty (cachexia, low albumin)

## HIGH RISK FOR INFECTION

- Random BS > 200 or HbA1C > 9% and CUSP procedures:
  - o Instrumented lumbar or thoracic fusions
  - Abdominal GYN surgery
  - o Abdominal colorectal surgery
  - o Open vascular surgery on abdomen or lower extremities
  - Total knee or total hip

## HIGH RISK FOR INTRA-OP PULMONARY COMPLICATIONS

- If BMI 50 and robotic surgery, or
- If BMI 40 with history of PAH and robotic surgery, then
- Refer to Pulmonary Hypertension Clinic, Dr Taghizadeh

## HIGH RISK FOR PERIOPERATIVE CVA

• Stroke in last 3 months
