PEDIATRIC SURGERY AT ALL SW LOCATIONS

Given the fact that we have no anesthesiologists specialized in pediatrics on staff,

and referring to the <u>American College of Surgeons Optimal Resources for Children's Surgical Care</u> <u>Guidelines, July 2022</u>, <u>American Academy of Pediatrics Critical Elements for the Pediatric</u> Anesthesia Environment, December 2015

- We will **not** be providing anesthesia for any patient 12 months old and younger regardless of how minor the case
- We will not do any case requiring intubation for any patient 6 years old and younger,
 except for minor ENT procedures on healthy patients 36 months old and older
- We will **not** be doing cases requiring intubation for patients less than 14 years old with special needs or with complicated medical histories (ASA 3 or higher)
- There is no restriction for patients 14 years old and older for minor or intermediate cases, pending the availability of post-op resources for potential observation and/or admission
