

SWA POLICY ON NEURAXIAL ANESTHESIA for the THROMBOCYTOPENIC PARTURIENT

November 9, 2022

- 1. The platelet count on admission for delivery must be at least 80K to receive neuraxial anesthesia
- 2. Platelet counts of 100K and above will be considered safe, barring extraordinary circumstances
- 3. Platelet counts of 80K to 99K will require a case-by-case risk-benefit analysis by the anesthesiologist at the time of admission for delivery. Factors to consider may include:
 - Concomitant use of anticoagulant or antiplatelet drugs
 - History of a possible bleeding disorder
 - Conditions that may lead to DIC:
 - o PIH
 - o Preeclampsia
 - o Abruption
 - o Fetal demise
 - Findings on H&P:
 - Abnormal airway exam
 - Abnormal lumbar spine exam
 - o Bruising
